This is in response to an application received on behalf of Darol Rodrock for a Department of the Army (DA) permit. The proposed work concerns construction of a pond referred to in your application as East Rodrock Lake involving the placement of fill material within a tributary of Wolf Creek. The project is located in Section 11, Township 15 South, Range 24 East, Johnson County, Kansas.

The Corps of Engineers has jurisdiction over all waters of the United States. Discharges of dredged or fill material in waters of the United States, including wetlands, require prior authorization from the Corps under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act (33 USC 1344). The implementing regulation for this Act is found at 33 CFR 320-330. An approved jurisdictional determination was previously provided for the tributary reach associated with the project site.

We have reviewed the information furnished and have determined that your project is authorized by nationwide permit (NWP) 42 provided you ensure that the conditions listed in the enclosed copy of excerpts from the March 12, 2007 Federal Register, Issuance of Nationwide Permits, as corrected, are met. You must also comply with the Kansas City District Regional NWP Conditions posted at: http://www.nwk.usace.army.mil/regulatory/regulatory.htm.

The Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) has certified that this NWP will not violate existing state water quality standards provided you comply with the conditions included in their attached letter. All conditions included in the water quality certification become conditions of the NWP authorization, please carefully review all conditions associated with this NWP. General condition 26 requires you to sign and submit the enclosed "Compliance

Certification" upon completion of the authorized work and any required mitigation.

This NWP verification is valid for two years from the date of this letter. Should your project plans change or if your activity is not complete within the specified verification term, you must contact this office for another permit determination.

In addition to the general conditions of this permit verification, the following special condition applies to this permit:

The mitigation plan submitted by Terra Technologies per letter dated August 25, 2008 for the impact of the project upon jurisdictional tributary channel within the project area must be carried out as proposed in the mitigation plan documents. The stream impacts assessed for the project equaled 2,480 debits that will be mitigated by stream channel restoration, riparian corridor and wetland work equivalent to 2,484 credits at a 3<sup>rd</sup> party mitigation site owned by Habitat Missouri, LLC on a tributary of Coffee Creek. A conservation easement provided to MMOA for this mitigation area will provide for protection of the site. A copy of this easement must be provided to this office within 90 days of any work within jurisdictional waters of the U.S. at the project site.

Although an individual DA permit is not required, other Federal, state and/or local permits may be required. You should verify this yourself.
