Dear Mr. Flick,

This letter serves as notification that the Upper Osage Wetland and Stream Umbrella Mitigation Bank, which includes the Pottawatomie Creek Mitigation Site #1 (Mitigation Site #1), is approved. Mitigation Site #1 is located adjacent to Pottawatomie Creek, in Sections 13 and 24, Township 18 South, Range 21 East and in Section 18, Township 18 South, Range 22 East, in Miami County, Kansas. The signature pages of the interagency review team (IRT) members are enclosed for inclusion in your copy of the final mitigation banking instrument (MBI).

As stated in Section V of the Final Mitigation Plan, the mitigation activities performed at Mitigation Site #1 will potentially generate 95.62 acres of wetland credits and 72,593 stream credits. In accordance with Section V (B) of the final MBI, the Corps will release 20 percent of the potential wetland and stream credits upon receipt of an irrevocable letter of credit and recorded conservation easement. An additional 30 percent of the potential wetland and stream credits will be released after receipt of acceptable as-built drawings and the first monitoring report demonstrating wetland hydrology at wetland sample locations.

The Corps, in consultation with the IRT, will review annual monitoring reports and release the balance of potential credits based on achievement of the ecological performance standards described in Section IV (H) of the final MBI and Section VIII of the Final Mitigation Plan for Mitigation Site #1. In addition to the final monitoring report, the final credit release will require IRT approval of the long-term management plan including financial assurances.


